April 15, 2024

The Kortright Town Board held a Regular Monthly Meeting on April 15, 2024 at 7:30pm in the Town Hall, 51702 State Highway 10, Bloomville, New York.

The privilege of the floor was granted to the Councilmember's. The tree limb is no longer hanging over the stones at the cemetery; not sure if someone took it down or the wind. But it looks like someone ran into the stonewall; we will look into getting that fixed.

The privilege of the floor was granted to the Highway Superintendent Bill Burdick. Bill reported that the truck at Zuill should be done in one to two weeks, they needed to do a battery shutoff for insurance purposes and that is almost done is all the trucks and the Cazenovia truck no word. The trees by the park are scheduled for removal just waiting on good weather.

On a motion made by Councilman Pietrantonio and seconded by Councilman Haynes to get rid of the fuel tank down by the salt shed; Dianich may trade for materials.
