

Kortright Town Board
Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes
May 19, 2025

The Kortright Town Board held a Regular Monthly Meeting on May 19, 2025 at 7:30pm in the Town Hall, 51702 State Highway 10, Bloomville, New York.

Present: Councilman Micheal Pietrantonio, Councilman Jeff Haynes, Councilman Nikki Pickett and Supervisor George Haynes Jr.

Absent: Councilman Chad Boest

Other Present: Rose Scully, Liz Page, LVDV Michael Harrington

Supervisor Haynes, Jr. called the Regular Monthly meeting to order at 7:30pm.

The April 21, 2025 GDBG Public Hearing, Bid Opening and Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes and were approved on a motion made by Councilman Pietrantonio and seconded by Councilman Haynes.

Supervisor Haynes, Jr. opened the floor to the Special Topics. Michael Harrington from LVDV presented the Board with a proposal for engineering services for a new well source in the Bloomville Water District. The Department of Health is pressuring the Town to drill another well as only one of the three is functioning. Michael suggests that we include a hydrogeological consultant on this project. Supervisor Haynes, Jr. stated that the district owns 40 acres that could be sold and that money could be used and it might be okay to use the Capital Reserves for this project. The proposal is \$9,500.00 and on a motion made by Councilman Pietrantonio and seconded by Councilman Pickett to spend \$3,000-\$4,000 to find out what can be done to secure another well source.

Rose would be happy if the busses were gone.
